Formed in 2008, our first honorees continue to be outstanding ambassadors in Michigan to teach, promote and share the sport of Geocaching. This group currently owns 389 caches that include hosting 79 events, with 311 hides and a Lost & Found Event to their credit. While hosting 3 Cache In Trash Out event annually, they have accumulated 13 CITO events as they continue to clean their Adopt-a-Highway. This group has also hosted two August events in conjunction with the Puddingstone Festival in Cheboygan. Our honorees have hosted 7 annual fall events between Cheboygan and Camp Pet-O-Se-Ga that have featured Geocaching 101 classes for their first 4 years & GSAK 101 class in the 3rd year. Years 5, 6 & 7 have included new cacher assistance and they even include a Rubber Duck Race in the 5th year of this popular event. They have worked exceptional well with local sponsors and groups such as the Emmet County Parks & Recreation and the Great Lakes Lighthouse Keepers Association to support their Fall Fest Geocaching Bash events. The Board Members of MiGO felt this resume was more than enough to justify awarding a Silver Coin award. When we began our research for this presentation we found there was so much more.
